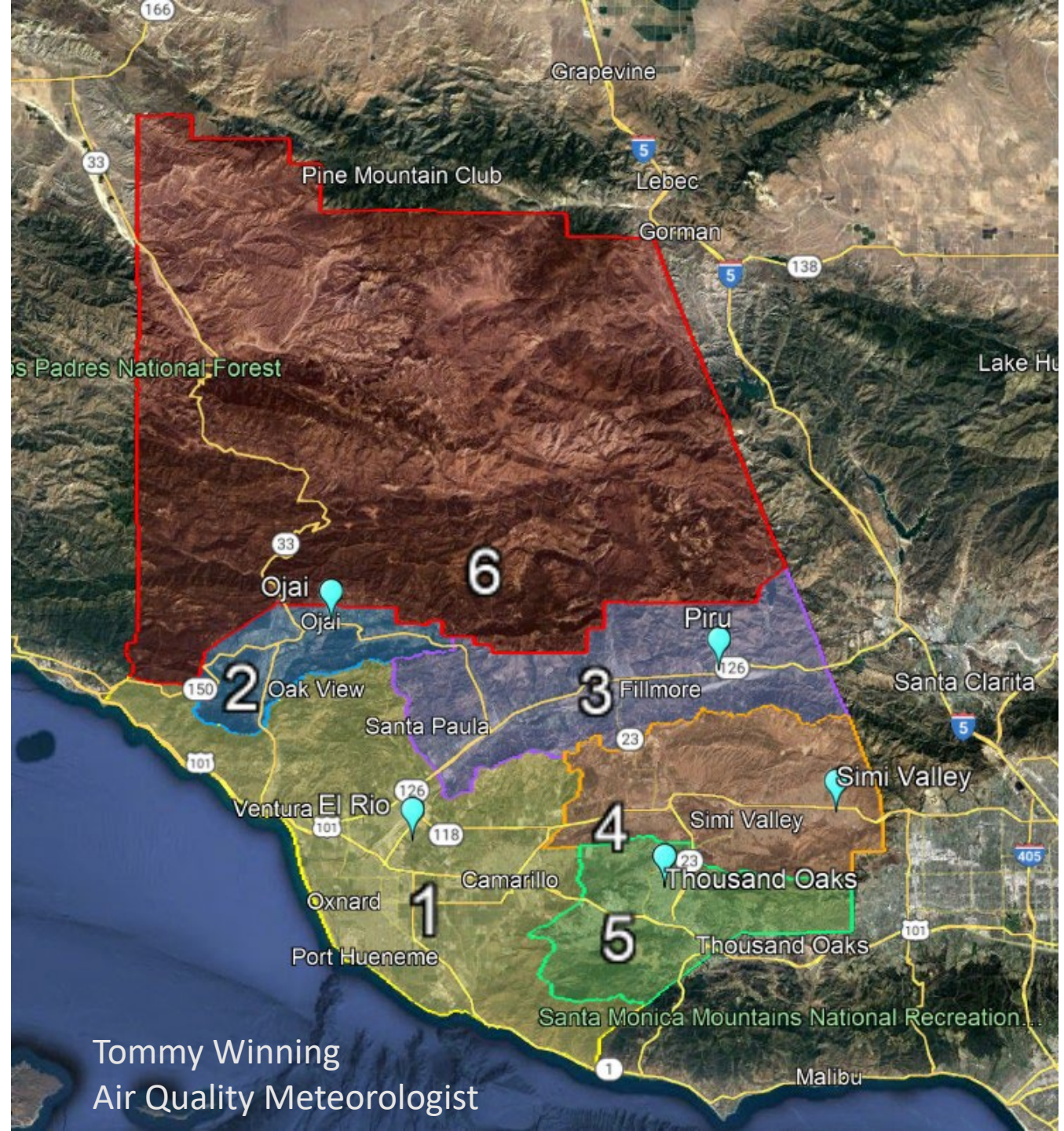

MINIMUM BURNING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

This permit is issued to the above applicant to burn the material at the location described above subject to the following terms:

1. No burning during windy weather. This includes winds over 15 mph and from _____ direction.
2. Permit void during suspension of burning proclamations by the Ventura County Fire Chief.
3. This permit is valid only during those days which are not prohibited by the State Air Resources Board, pursuant to Section 41855 of the Health and Safety Code, or by the Ventura County APCD. Must comply with all conditions of Rule 56 APCD.
4. Agricultural waste shall be dried as required, arranged to facilitate efficient burning, free of visible moisture, ignited with approved devices, and be free of other wastes such as tires, rubbish, tar paper or construction debris.
5. It is the applicant's responsibility to notify Fire District Communications Center on day of burn.
6. It is the applicant's responsibility to notify APCD of planned & completed burn 48 hours before and after.
7. Burning operation authorized by this permit is located in an area cleared of flammable vegetation, it shall be: (a) attended by at least one able-bodied adult person at all times; (b) confined within cleared firebreaks or barriers adequate to prevent it from escaping control; (c) regulated in size at all times to insure proper control by the number of adult persons attending it.
8. When the burning operation authorized by this permit is a campfire or warming fire, a minimum clearance of 10 feet from all flammable material must be maintained. The fire must be attended at all times by at least 1 able-bodied adult.
9. This permit does not relieve the permittee of any duty to use reasonable and ordinary care to prevent damage to the property of others or injury to persons as prescribed by law.
10. This permit valid for burn days during the period of _____ to _____.

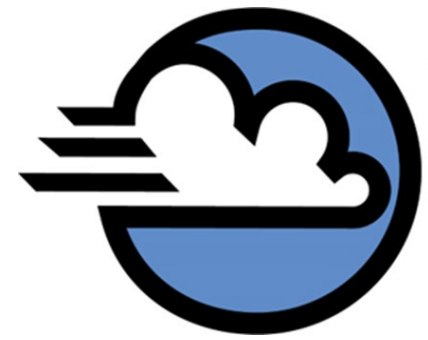

Burn Permits

- No fee to obtain a burn permit
- Required fields on the permit:
 - Applicant name/ number /signature
 - Location of burn
 - Material to be burned
 - Amount of material (piles and tons)
 - Expiration date
 - Additional Fire Department Requirements
 - Any additional requirements become part of the permit
 - Fire Captain signature

Prescribed Burning

- The planned application and confinement of fire to wildland fuels on lands selected in advance of that application to achieve specific identified objectives.
 - Prevention of high intensity wildland fires
 - Watershed Management
 - Range Improvement
 - Vegetation Management
 - Forest Improvement
 - Wildlife Habitat Improvement
 - Air Quality Maintenance
