The GOAL of the CA-GLC partners is to utilize this capacity to bring together diverse partners in the State for the purpose of shared learning and enhanced delivery of grazing lands conservation technical assistance to address resource concerns and build ecological and economic resiliency. This effort meets current needs on grazing lands and serves as an investment for the next generation of livestock producers and grazing lands resource professionals in California.

Objectives of the CA-GLC partners:

- Collectively develop a formal strategy that identifies and prioritizes durable pathways for the delivery of technical assistance and education on ecologically and economically beneficial strategies for the stewardship of grazing lands in the State
- Facilitate knowledge exchange and continued learning on climate-smart grazing strategies to address drought resiliency, invasive species, wildfire risk and recovery, and other local resource concerns
- Dedicate capacity to outreach and technical assistance to tribal communities and grazing lands managers, along with engage them in GLC leadership and strategic planning
- Participate in the planning, outreach, and delivery of opportunities designed to engage diverse practitioners, students and other stakeholders in grazing lands stewardship
- Engage CA GLC partners in a west-wide grazing lands network to address common challenges and support collaborative conservation opportunities at a western region scale
