Ford Definition Amendment, 2023

Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations

Division 1.5, Chapter 4,

Subchapter 1

§ 895.1. Definitions

"Ford" means a Logging Road Watercourse crossing where the road grade dips through the Watercourse channel. <u>This includes but is not limited to one of the following</u>

o construction types:

- "Rock-armored crossing" means a Logging Road Watercourse crossing
 where fill is placed in the channel to establish a usable road grade and the
 outfall of the crossing and road surface are protected against scour by
 revetment composed of rock.
- "Rock-fill crossing" means a Logging Road Watercourse crossing where rock
 that is free of fines is placed as fill in the channel to establish a usable road
 grade through the crossing.
- "Vented crossing" means a Logging Road Watercourse crossing designed to allow low water flow in the stream channel to pass through the structure, usually through a culvert, and high water flow to pass over the roadway.

- p road surface crosses at the natural grade of the channel and the channel surface is composed of stable native material sufficient to support crossing use.
