1640.3. Examinations Prescribed. The examination shall test the applicant's understanding of the significant concept in and working knowledge of (1) Forest Economics, (2) Forest Protection, (3) Silviculture, (4) Forest Resources Management, (5) Forest Resources Use, (6) Dendrology, (7) Forest Ecology, (8) Forest Mensuration, (9) Forest Policy, and (10) Forest Administration as these apply to the management of forest lands to produce goods and services, and in terms of the environmental effects of such activities.
