
## **CalVTP MMRP Implementation Tools**



- <sup>1</sup> Proceed with treatment in compliance with other applicable measures.
- <sup>2</sup> Dormant Season: When the plant has no aboveground parts, which would typically occur after seed set and before germination<sup>5</sup>.
- <sup>3</sup> If surveys are conducted outside of the blooming period, all plant species will be conservatively identified to genus.
- <sup>4</sup> Document as evidence that treatment would be beneficial in the PSA, PSA/Addendum.
- <sup>5</sup> Germination: Typically, germination will occur after the first significant rainfall (approximately 0.5 inches) and cold snap, which generally occur October-December.
